

Action and event planning of the quarter

October 2015:

 10/30/15 – Martinique: End of stay in Martinique of a young Haitian boy, treated at the University Hospital of Martinique with cardiac surgery, under the Medical and Pediatric cooperation program.

November 2015:

- 11/14/2015 to 11/21/2015 Haiti: Field mission (Port au Prince/Thiotte) for the preparation of the launch of the 1st phase of the water resource management project in Belle Anse district and the organization of meetings with implementing and institutional partners (ACTED, CODAB, etc.).
- November Martinique: Establishment of a COBATY/ESA steering committee for the monitoring and evaluation of the construction and development project in My Father's House orphanage in Port au Prince.
- **11/21 to 11/24/2015 Martinique:** ESA-Caraïbes' participation at the **National Congress of Pediatric Cardiology** (Schoelcher).

December 2015:

- December 2015 / January 2016 Martinique: Logistic and administrative organization for the treatment of three Haitian children at the University Hospital of Martinique (interventional cardiac catheterism), under the Medical and Pediatric cooperation program.
- December Haiti: Water resource management project: in partnership with ACTED, CODAB, ODE-Martinique and in collaboration with the DINEPA, launch of the construction works on Thiotte water systems to supply the city with drinking water (renovation of water catchment, pipelines, installation of a hydraulic pump for the tank and fountains rehabilitation).



Haiti: Childhood and disabilities



My Father's House orphanage

Since 2010, ESA-Caraïbes has been supporting My Father's House orphanage, in Port-au-Prince, Haiti. ESA-Caraïbes has been working to improve the hosting and living conditions of the 200 children housed in the orphanage by funding pediatric care and sanitation, education and learning support, sport activities, recreational outings, and various donations: food items, toys, clothes, books, school materials, hygiene and cleaning products, etc.

In partnership with the St Pierre-Martinique Rotary Club, ESA-Caraïbes funded from 2014 to mid-2015 a nutrition program and organized the service of complete and healthy meals once a week for the 200 to children. Fundraising initiatives are ongoing to relaunch the activities.

Since 2012, in cooperation with the "Fondation Architectes de l'Urgence" in Haiti, and since 2014 with the financial support of COBATY, the BEL Foundation and St Pierre-Martinique Rotary Club, ESA-Caraïbes is supporting MFH orphanage in a construction project that aims to host the children in a safe environment and to secure their well-being and development.

Supporting young people with disabilities

In collaboration with the Martinique General Council and Martinican hosting-families, ESA-Caraïbes is supporting the reintegration in their home country of young Haitians with disabilities who have been hospitalized in Martinique following the January 12, 2010 earthquake.

School sponsorship

For the school year 2015-2016, ESA-Caraïbes is running a student sponsorship program for a dozen children from vulnerable families of Port-au-Prince.

Transport of various supplies

In collaboration with various partners, ESA-Caraïbes participates in donation collections in Martinique in favor of vulnerable children in Haiti and works toward a regular container shipping from Martinique to Haiti.



Medical and pediatric cooperation in the Caribbean

Health professional trainings,

Specialized consultations and assistance to diagnostic

In partnership with a Caribbean health professional network, ESA-Caraïbes is setting up a specialized pediatric care and professional training coordination over the Caribbean, including Dominica, St Lucia, and Haiti, in the medical expertise of cardiology, neurology, oncology and neonatalogy. Under this program, more than 100 health professionals will follow specific training modules each year.

ESA-Caraïbes organizes, related to these medical specialties, specialized consultations and assistance to diagnostic, and in doing so, an organized care system. Each year, hundreds of children benefit from specialized consultations.

Medical care and treatment in Martinique of children suffering from complex diseases

Along with various partners such as Martinican and Caribbean organizations and American NGOs, ESA-Caraïbes is receiving and funding the hospitalization in Martinique of Caribbean children from vulnerable families and suffering from complex diseases. Under this program, **10 children are treated each year**.

Our partners: M3C Antilles-Guyane Center, Gift Of Life International, Cardiac Alliance Haiti, Open Hearts Haiti, Word Pediatric Project, St Lucia-RISE, Dominica-CHF, Air Caraïbes.

Through this program, more than fostering the University Hospital of Martinique activity, ESA-Caraïbes is also contributing to the international outreach of Martinique and to the recognition of the high quality level of its technical platform throughout the Caribbean. This program also initiates a Caribbean regional health area and enhances common strategies.





Haiti: support for community development

Water resource management project in the South East

In partnership with the INGO ACTED, the Water Agencies of Martinique (Office de l'Eau-Martinique, Société Martiniquaise des Eaux/Lyonnaise des Eaux), the National Direction of Drinking Water and Sanitation in Haiti (DINEPA) and the Haitian Community Organization of Belle Anse (Coordination des Organisations pour le Développement de l'Arrondissement de Belle-Anse/CODAB), ESA-Caraïbes is working on a sustainable response to the water resource issue in the South-East department. A water resource management program in the Belle Anse region has been elaborated to respond to the emergency context linked to the severe drought, and, in a mid and long term approach, to study, design and implement a Water management master plan, providing an optimal, sustainable and economic resources management, benefiting the populations of the region.

Decentralized cooperation project, Haiti-Martinique

ESA-Caraïbes is supporting four towns in the Thiotte area in a decentralized cooperation project with an urban community of Martinique. Belle-Anse district, which includes these four cities, has a population of 150,000 people.
